■ On-Demand Technical Assistance

■ Strategic Technical Assistance Response Team (START)

- Laser-focused Technical Assistance for a specific project
- Two rounds already executed in Alaska
 - Second round had funding help (\$250K)
- Round 3 coming later this year

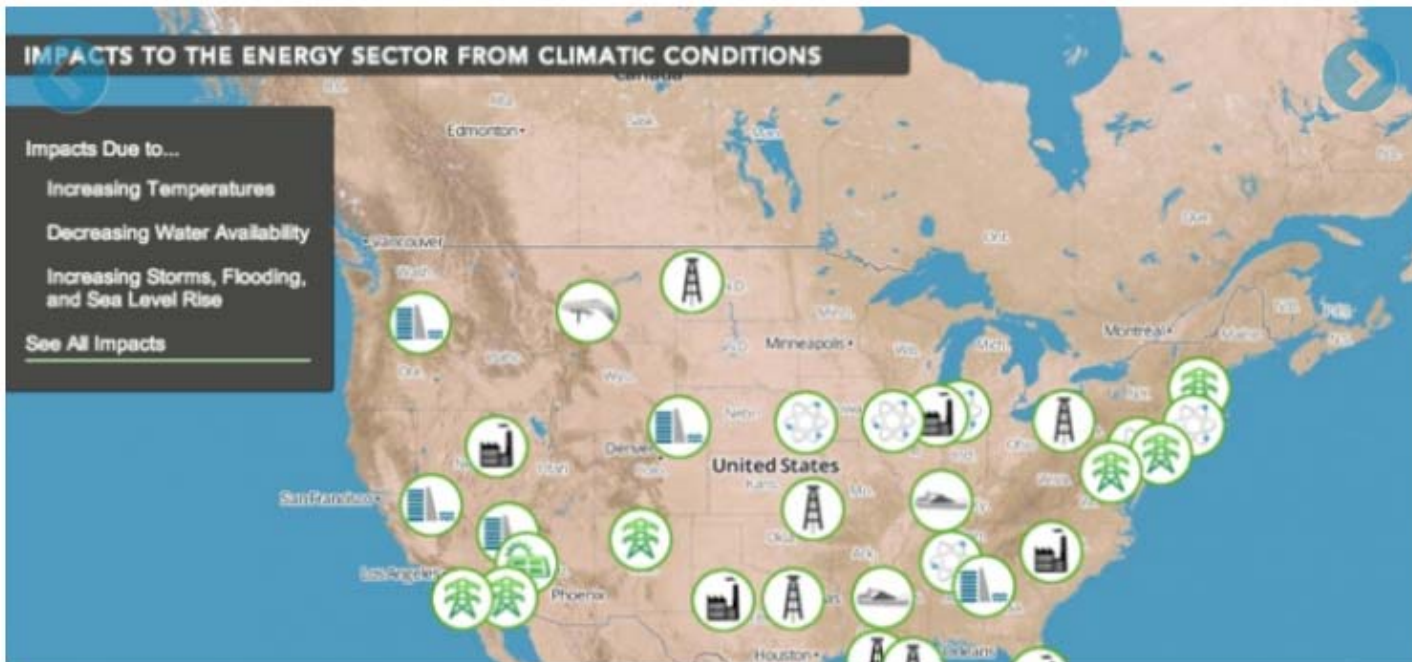

Up to \$7 million in funding is available to accelerate clean energy development on tribal lands. Through this funding opportunity announcement (FOA), the Tribal Energy Program, in cooperation with the DOE Office of Indian Energy, will help Indian Tribes, tribal energy resource development organizations, and tribal consortia:

1. Install clean energy and energy efficiency retrofit projects for tribal buildings, and
2. Deploy clean energy systems on a community scale.
